MANSH1P PARK RULES

Manship Park rules have been formulated for the protection of each and every patron. Following these simple rules, makes

it possible for everyone to have a safe and enjoyable experience. Although a proactive approach is taken by having the

park regularly patrolled, we ask our patrons to be our extra set of eyes and ears. Please help us to preserve and maintain

all property and structures within Manship Park. If you see suspicious activity in the park, please call 911 immediately.

For all non-emergency situations, you may contact Danielson Troop D Police Department at (860) 779-4900, or the Canterbury Town Selectman's Office at (860) 546-9693.

• Manship Park closes at dusk. All individuals and vehicles must vacate the premises at this time. Overnight parking

is prohibited.

- Park speed limit is 5 MPH.
- All patrons must abide by the park rules and conduct themselves in an orderly manner.
 - Foul and abusive language is prohibited.
 - Children under the age of 16 are to be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Parents/Guardians are required to supervise your child at all times, and are responsible for your child's conduct.
- No person except law enforcement officers, shall use, carry, or possess any firearm within the park.
- Possession and/or use of alcohol beverages or unauthorized controlled substances, is strictly prohibited.

Use of marajuana or THC containing products is not allowed.

- Open fires are not allowed.
- Smoking in any form is prohibited.
- All patrons are to take out what you brought in.
- Glass containers are not allowed.
- Motorized recreational vehicles such as, but not limited to, dirt bikes, four wheelers, golf carts, mini bikes, go-carts,

snowmobiles, ATV's, etc., are prohibited.

• Bicyclists must wear a helmet at all times, and are allowed to ride on the track only. Riders must ride on the right

hand side of the track, yielding the right of way to walkers. Bicycles are not allowed to b.e ridden in the parking lot,

or on any of the athletic fields.

■ Dogs are to be kept on a leash no longer than 6 feet, and kept under control at all times. At no time, are dogs

allowed to run freely, or left tied up unattended.

- Dog waste must be cleaned IMMEDIATELY.
- Dog owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries caused by them, as well as ensuring they are

licensed and up to date on their shots.

• Dogs are not allowed to enter the soccer fields, baseball fields, volleyball courts, or children's playscape at any

time.

- Aggressive dogs are to be removed from the park immediately.
- Golfing and/or chipping of golf balls is not allowed.

• Any person found in violation of the existing rules, or having created a public nuisance or potential hazard to

persons or property, or exhibiting disorderly conduct, shall be expelled from park and subject to appropriate legal measures.
