Child Find



Identify. Locate. Evaluate.

What is Child Find?

Child Find is the process by which districts and public charter schools **identify** and **locate** children needing evaluation.

All children birth to their 22^{nd} birthday with disabilities or suspected of having a disability, regardless of the severity of their disabilities, and who are in need of special education and related services, must be identified, located, and evaluated.

Who can be part of child find?

- Any child age birth to their 22nd birthday with a disability or suspected of having a disability.
- Anyone concerned about a child can contact Canterbury Pupil Services for information and next steps.
- Canterbury Public Schools is responsible for finding all students, including those attending private schools, homeschooled and homeless children.

If your family lives in any of these situations:

- A homeless shelter
- Doubled up with other people
- Car, park, empty building, bus or train station
- Motel or campground
